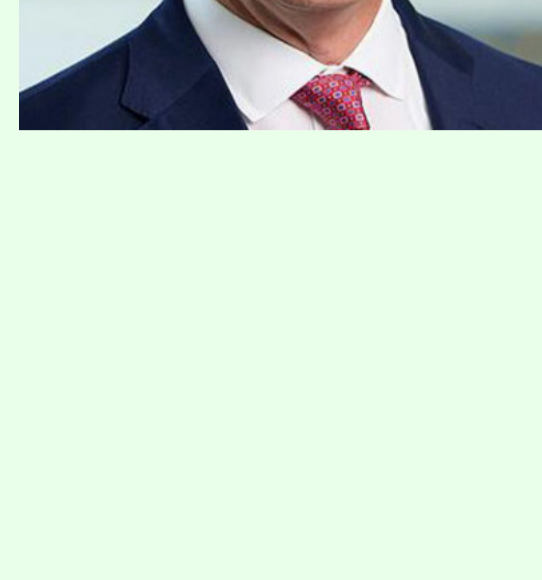
## Featured Hall of Fame Honorees

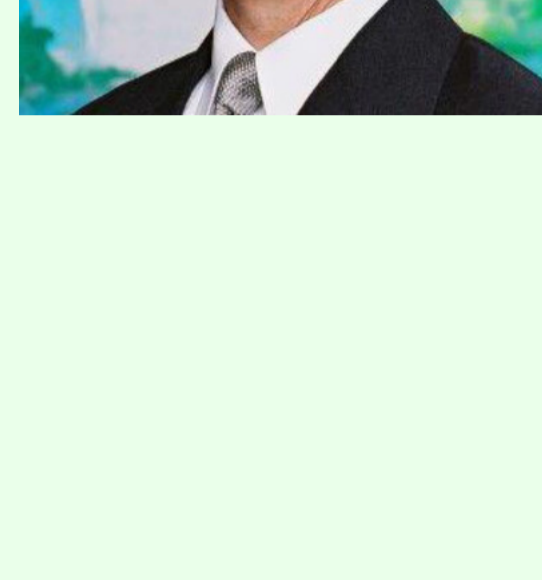

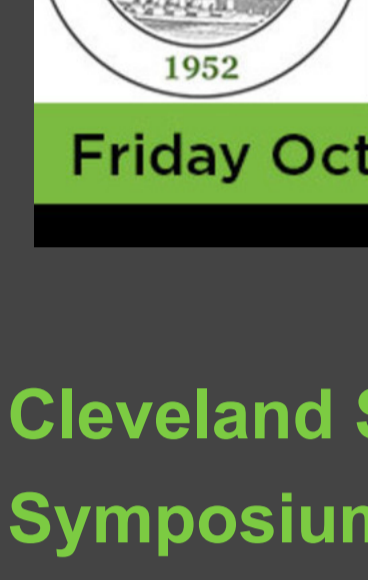

### Cleveland State Law Review Symposium: The Future of the Fourteenth Amendment: *Autonomy and Equality Post-Dobbs v. Jackson*

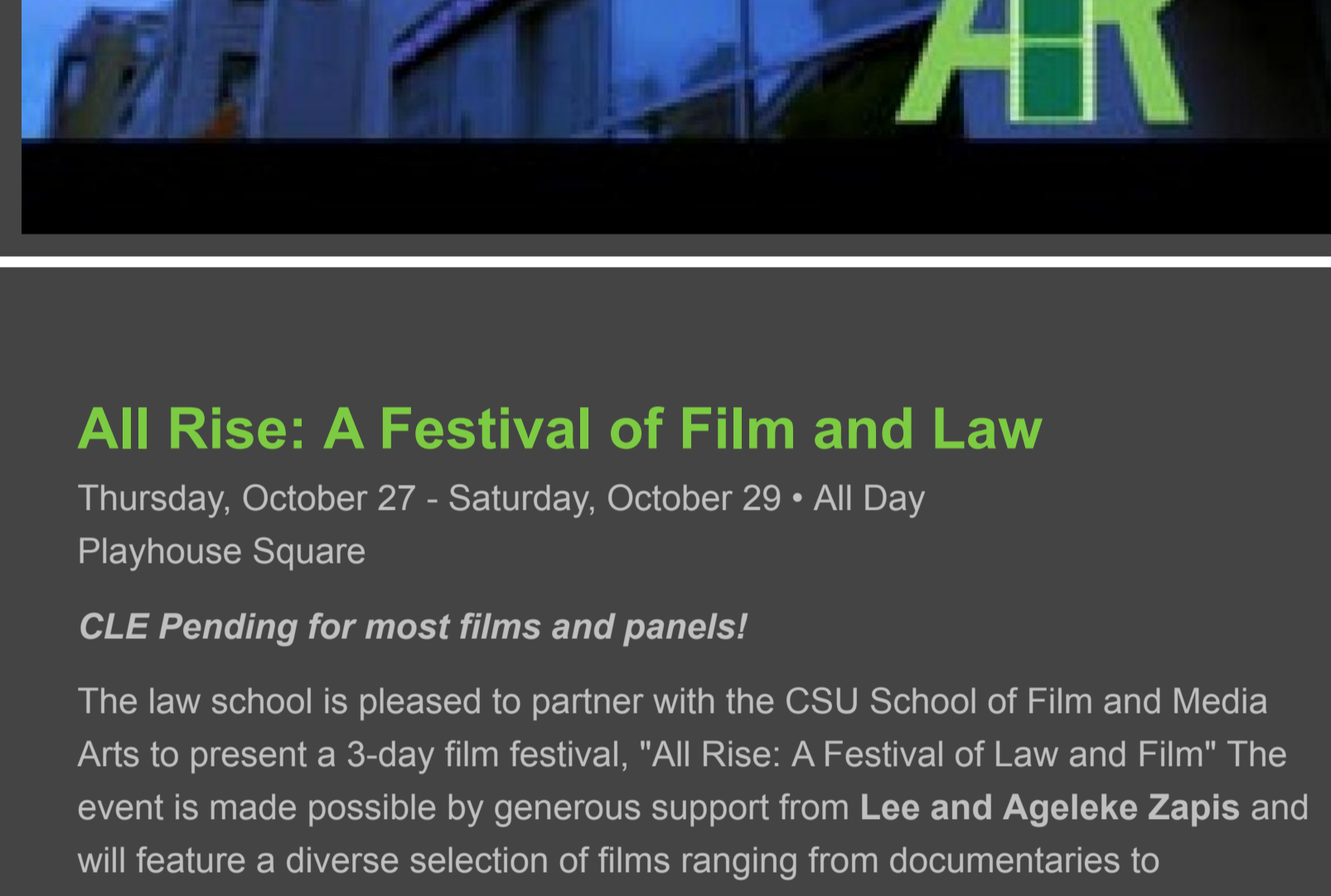

Following two online symposiums, *Cleveland State Law Review* returns to an in-person format. The Symposium brings students, attorneys and leading legal scholars from all over the country to discuss the timely and important topic of the future of our rights and equality after the *Dobbs v. Jackson* decision overruled *Roe v. Wade* and the right to terminate a pregnancy. The event will include a keynote address by Professor Kim Forde-Mazur, director of the Center for the Study of Race and Law at University of Virginia School of Law, and panels covering the constitutional interpretation of the Fourteenth Amendment, critical perspectives on equality and autonomy, and the effects of *Dobbs v. Jackson*. In addition to this important discussion, we will also highlight the relationship between the protection of rights, art, and activism with our first art exhibit, as well as a panel discussing the role that art plays in the law.

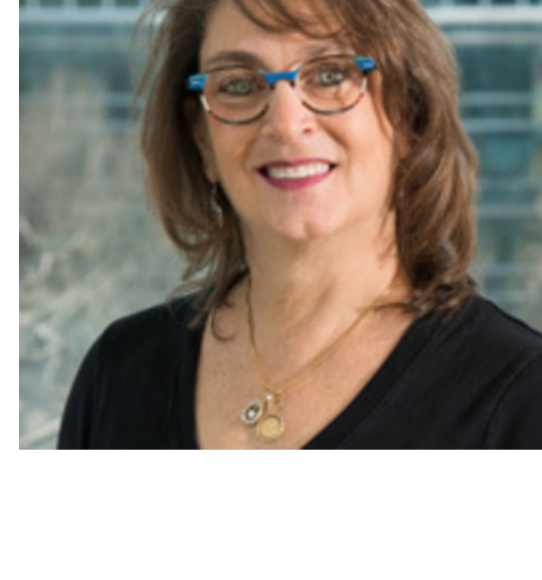

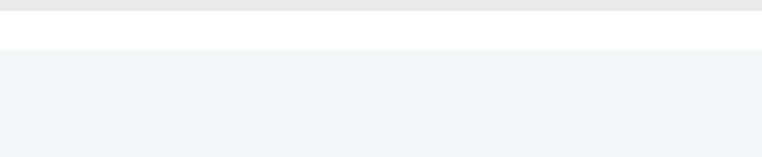

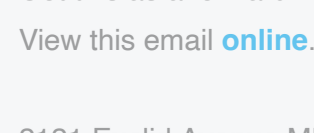
