

his program will cover three broad topics: (1) An exploration of the ethical rules, both the Ohio Code of Professional Responsibility and the ABA Model Rules, on what constitutes the unauthorized practice of law and the issues to consider when an Ohio attorney acts in a legal capacity in another state; (2) What exactly is professionalism? What are the relevant considerations and limits? Does a prospective client want a lawyer who is professional or can the client even detect the difference; is the client more interested in an effective lawyer as opposed to a professional one?; (3) The who, how and why of the impaired lawyer: the causes, treatment and prevention of impairment are well documented and will be discussed. What about the detection of impairment, though? How can you be sure and how sure do you need to be?
