



C|M|LAW Posts Record Employment Rate for Class of 2018

Cleveland-Marshall announced that its 2018 graduating class achieved a 95.5% employment rate 10 months after graduation. This is the highest employment rate for C|M|LAW since the Great Recession hit in 2007. It follows on the heels of the [state-high 93% pass rate](#) for the July 2018 Ohio bar examination.

"This has been a year of rising success for C|M|LAW," said **Dean Lee Fisher**. "We are so proud of the achievements of our graduates. They are resilient, hard-working and determined, and their bar pass rate and employment rate reflect those characteristics."

In addition to the 95% total employment rate, more than 80% of the class is employed in full-time, long-term jobs that require bar passage or for which the law degree is an advantage.
