Admission as a visiting student is limited to the semester(s) and course(s) for which the status is expressly granted.

Registration priority for all courses is given to Cleveland State University College of Law degree candidates and the College reserves the right to withhold registration approval or to deregister visiting students if insufficient places are available in any course(s) for the College's qualified degree candidates. Subject to the foregoing, all rules and regulations of the College of Law are applicable to transient students.

## **Required documents:**

- A completed Visiting Student Application and \$40 application fee (made payable to Cleveland State University), submitted to: CSU College of Law, Office of Admissions, 2121 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44115
- A Letter of Good Standing from your current law school, stating that you are eligible to continue your legal education at that institution;
- A letter from your current law school stating:
  - 1. The semesters for which you have been granted permission to enroll at CSU College of Law;
    - 2. The course names (with credit hours) for which you have been granted permission to take at CSU College of Law; and
    - 3. That your current law school will accept credit for satisfactorily completed work at CSU College of Law.
